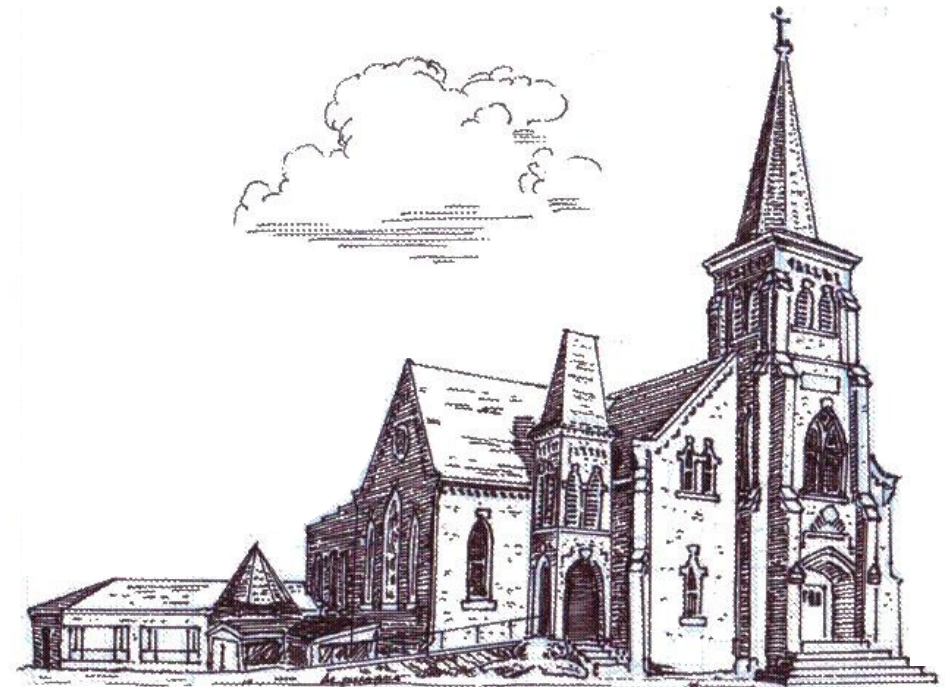

CHANGE IN CHILDREN'S PROGRAM REHEARSALS—Our Sunday School children and youth will NOT have a rehearsal this Tuesday, November 27. They will have rehearsals during the Sunday School hour today, December 2 and December 9. On Friday, December 14, rehearsal will be held from 5:30 to 8:00 pm, with dinner served. All children age 3 through high school are encouraged to participate. The program will be presented on Sunday, December 16, at 8:45 am followed by Snacks with Santa.

COVENANT CARDS for 2019 are available in the entryway and Hospitality Room. You are asked to consider how you might be able to support all the ministries that God will lead us towards next year. Numbers that were shared last Sunday report that Immanuel UMC has 78 possible giving households. Our budget for 2019 is \$218,580. Currently, we have 70 giving households. IF we divided our yearly budget between 78 giving units, our expenses would be equally balanced if each unit contributed \$234 a month. However, we know that possibly not everyone is able to give \$234 a month. So, as a community we are left with knowing what our own ability to give equals, and possibly fill in the gap for those who may not be able to afford \$234 a month.

ANGEL TREE MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES—Sign up to choose children who have at least one parent currently incarcerated. Our list includes 20 children in Madison County this year that we can serve by providing gifts on behalf of their parent, which will be delivered to their home the week of Christmas. It means so much to these kids to know their parent is thinking of them even though they can't be together during the holiday season. Look for the skinny tree with tags in the Hospitality Room. Gifts should be wrapped and returned to church by December 16. Recommended cost is \$20-25 per child. Any questions, see Rhonda Grammer.
