²⁹ By faith the people passed through the Red Sea as if it were dry land, but when the Egyptians attempted to do so they were drowned. ³⁰ By faith the walls of Jericho fell after they had been encircled for seven days. ³¹ By faith Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, because she had received the spies in peace. ³² And what more should I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets, ³³ who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions, ³⁴ quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. ³⁵ Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, refusing to accept release, in order to obtain a better resurrection. ³⁶ Others suffered mocking and flogging and even chains and imprisonment. ³⁷ They were stoned to death; they were sawn in two; they were killed by the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, persecuted, tormented—³⁸ of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains and in caves and holes in the ground. ³⁹ Yet all these, though they were commended for their faith, did not receive what was promised, ⁴⁰ since God had provided something better so that they would not, apart from us, be made perfect.

12 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, ² looking to Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.

Mandated Requirements for Volunteers Working with Children

- The State of Illinois requires anyone who cares for children in either a paid or volunteer role in schools, medical facilities, and in churches to complete a free DCFS training which can be found here: <https://mr.dcfstraining.org>. All staff and volunteers working with children in our church must complete the free online training from DCFS within 3 months of beginning their work with children. There is NO EXCEPTION for those who serve infrequently or at the last minute.
- Safe Gatherings is training that all Immanuel volunteers need to go through. It takes a couple of hours, but has great information. It is designed to keep our volunteers and those who come to our church safe. It is free for all volunteers. The link is safegatherings.com. When you get to the main page, click on the Start Application link. The information you will need includes: Language; Organization type—Church of faith-based organization; Denomination—Methodist; Country—United States; State—Illinois; Organization Name—Immanuel UMC Edwardsville. You will then need to register and start the training. Talk to David if you run into any issues.
