From the Pastor's Desk...

In Matthew 5, Jesus is delivering what we know as "The Sermon on the Mount." In this sermon, He calls us to be a light to the world. In other words, we should live out our ministry in a way that is seen by and enriches the world around us. In verses 14-16, Jesus says, "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. People do not light a lamp and put it under the bushel basket; rather, they put it on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

As a congregation, we do not serve in our community to shine a light on us, we we are called to do. Our hope is that the work we do brings glory to God and shares God's love with others. This call to "good works," is not just a collective call, but an individual call as well.
